The Long Way Home Project

The recent Ken Burns mini-series about the Viet-Nam War has provoked many different views and thoughts, and for some has reopened the wounds many still suffer with that war. Many feel

it is a fair and balanced view, while others believe it was a complete whitewash of the communist subjugation of the Republic of Viet-Nam and vindication of the anti-war movement here in this country. There is, no doubt a gulf of opinion.

POVA Life Member Robert Martinez led creation of a similar mini-series in the early 2000's. Known as "The Long Way Home Project," this series tells a very different story. For many Viet-Nam veterans, it more closely resembles the "truth" about the Viet-Nam War we fought, and portrays the war as exactly what it was....a war of subjugation by one country over another. While the main combatants were Viet-Namese, both North and South Viet-Nam were independent countries recognized by the United Nations and several dozen treaty agreements. This was no "civil war."

The POVA Biennial Reunion will have DVD's of "The Long Way Home Project" available for sale at a discounted price. Having watched the entire series, it is much less politically nuanced and seeks not to whitewash anything. Look for our POVA Store table at the Reunion in Cleveland.
